BSR - Driver Robert Hunter

BSR - The Car

The car to be used in this year's racing is a 1990 Van Diemen Formula Vauxhall Junior owed by the University of Derby.

Don't let the 1990 fool you the chassis is more than capable of winning. The engine is the same one that's in the Vauxhall Astra a 1600cc 8 valve and fuel injected. All 'car' preparation will be done at the University of Derby Motorsport Workshop in their new complex at Mark Eaton Street in Derby recently opened by Sir Richard Branson.

The car and engine will be fully checked and overhauled new parts added where required. It will then be tested using the in-house dynamometer and when the car is ready it will be fine-tuned on the rolling road before it ventures on to the track at Donington Park or Mallory.
